



## Co-Driver's In-Car 2: Intro to Making Turns

**Co-Driver in the passenger-side backseat:** Name the action as it is being performed. For example say: "The engines running, foot's on brake, shift's in drive, left signal is on," or "the signal wasn't used."

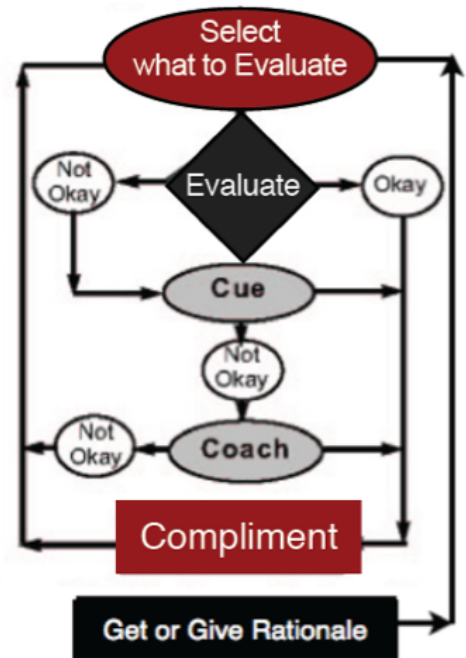
### Set 1a:

**The teen is to position the car to make a left turn.**

- Have the engine running
- Foot on brake
- Shift in drive
- Left signal light on

### Set 1b:

- Turn head to identify the Target and evaluate POT
  - Locate a simulated stop line and a curb line
  - \*\*c. Search Right, Front, Left for open Path-Of-Travel (POT)
  - Check outside mirror for clear B-rear zone
  - Move head forward to view mirror & roll eyes rearward
- \*\**First search is in the direction not turning.*



**Co-Driver in the passenger-side backseat:** State the action while it's being performed.

- Set 2:**
- Turn head to align with the target (*central vision*)
  - Foot off brake
  - Let idle speed move car
  - Turn steering wheel (*hand-over-hand, or hand-to-hand*)
  - Light acceleration
  - Make a smooth stop at the Transition Peg (*fringe vision*)

**Set 3:** While stopped at the Tpeg,

**The Coach asks teen:** "What actions should take place at the Tpeg?"

- Response:**
- Increase acceleration
  - Loosen grip on steering wheel
  - Have steering wheel spin back to straighten tires

**Step 4** Teen is to perform the complete turn without stopping.

- Search R, F, L for Open POT
- Check B-Rear Zone
- Turn head on target
- Foot off brake
- Let idle speed move car
- Turn steering wheel
- Light acceleration to Tpeg
- Increase acceleration at Tpeg
- Get speed to 15 mph
- Make a smooth "Staggered Stop."
- Creep to Make a "Legal Stop."
- Creep to Make a "Safety Stop."
