Assignment Using Google Earth:

1. Open Google Earth and Enter your home Address
2. Go to “Street View.”
3. Pretend you are walking on the sidewalk.
4. Find 10 LOS Blockages of a driveway, a street, or a vehicle.
5. Rotate each view to make a 45° Search.
6. Rotate each view to make a 90° Search.
7. Find vehicles in LP1, LP2, and LP3.
8. Make a screen capture of one of the ten views of 4, 5, 6, and 7.
9. Title your image to describe what you captured.
10. Save your Images in a folder to show them to your “coach.”



To enter Street View
drag this symbol to the street
you want to view.



Directions to Navigate Street View: Tap your cursor on the arrow for the direction you want to travel. You can also place your cursor on the screen and “scroll” up and down the roadway. Click and hold the cursor to rotate the image to get the 45° and 90° views.
