



Search A Zone for a car **tailgating** a vehicle making a right turn, **who may zigzag** into your path. Find vehicles that moved into LP 2.



Think of actions you could take if a car was heading towards you.

1. Reduce your speed
2. Find Escape Path - Take LP5
3. Flash high beam headlights
4. Blow your horn

A **“zigzagger”** is a driver who closes separation space and swings around to pass a turning vehicle rather than hold back in the lane,

Find “Slow” or “Go” Conditions and LP’s of Vehicles

Three things to Search the A Zone For

1. Look for **Slow** conditions.
2. Look for **Go** conditions
3. Look for the **LP** of vehicles ahead as well as oncoming.



When you find a vehicle in LP2, evaluate your C Zone to see if you would have an **escape path** to take if needed. Also note drivers who move to LP3 to make right turns. Give yourself a reward of knowing that you are building habits of Awareness to prevent crashes caused by wrongful actions.

Spend ten minutes at a time as a driver, co-driver, or as a pedestrian, on three different days to evaluate the LP position of vehicles and evaluate their speed. Judge the driver as to whether you believe the vehicle has the best LP and is using speed effectively.

Practice ten-minutes at a time until you can instantly judge the LP of oncoming vehicles and those ahead without any thought.
