



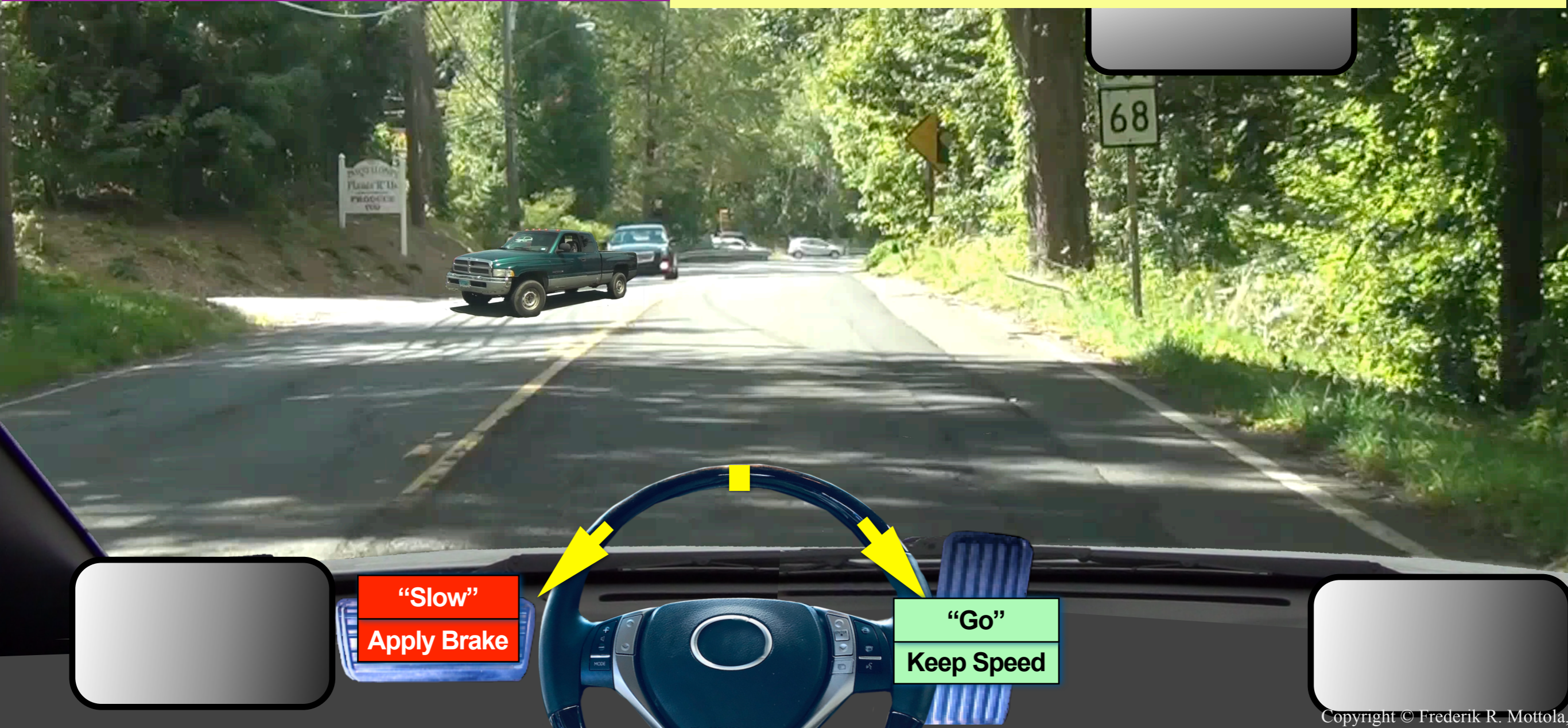
# Challenge Your MIND!

Is your POT “Open” or “Closed?” Are you in a “Go” or a “Slow” condition?

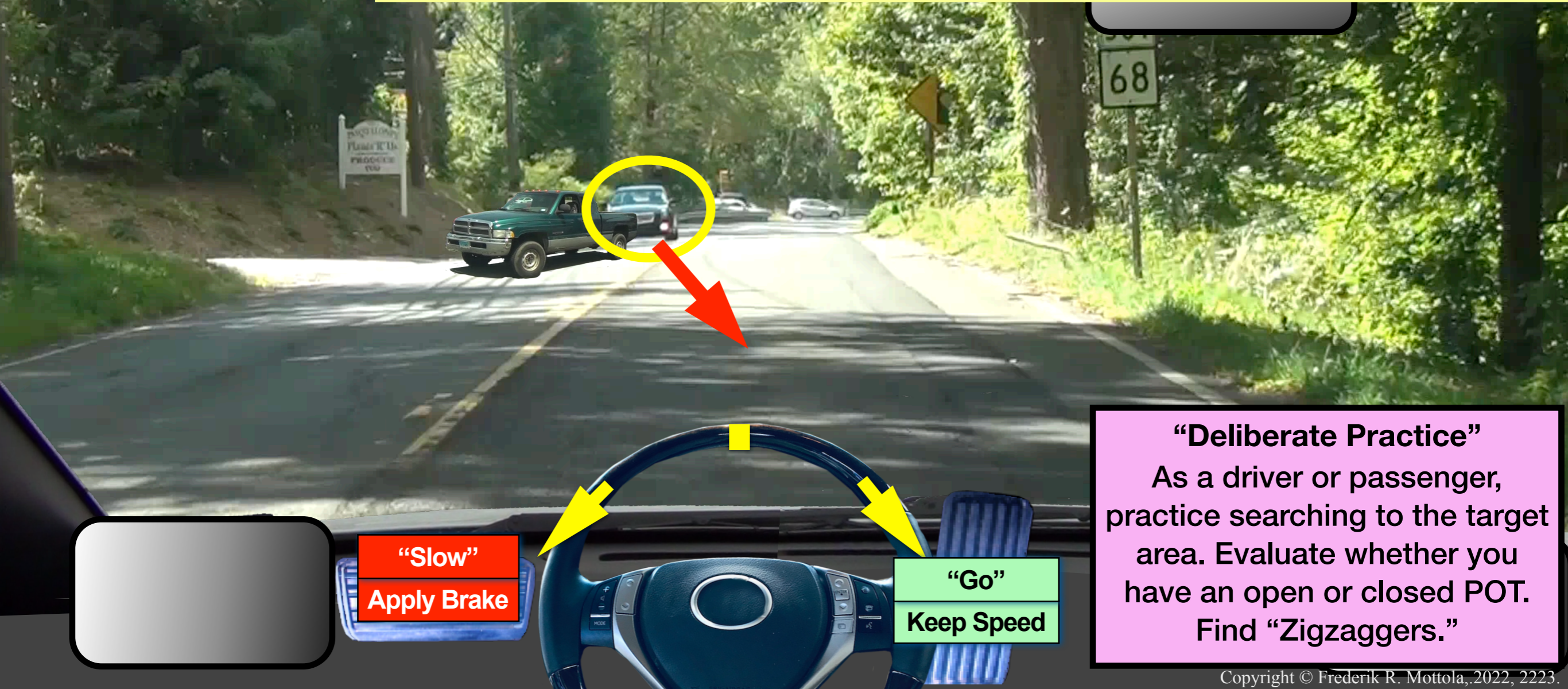
Think of your response, then advance slide.



“Slow”  
Apply Brake

“Go”  
Keep Speed

Your POT is “Closed” by the intersection in your target area. The truck making a right turn and a vehicle close behind create the “Slow” condition. You don’t know whether the driver in back of the truck will attempt to “zigzag” around it and cause a head-on crash in your POT. A “**zigzagger**” is a driver who swerves around a turning vehicle.



**“Deliberate Practice”**  
As a driver or passenger, practice searching to the target area. Evaluate whether you have an open or closed POT. Find “Zigzaggers.”



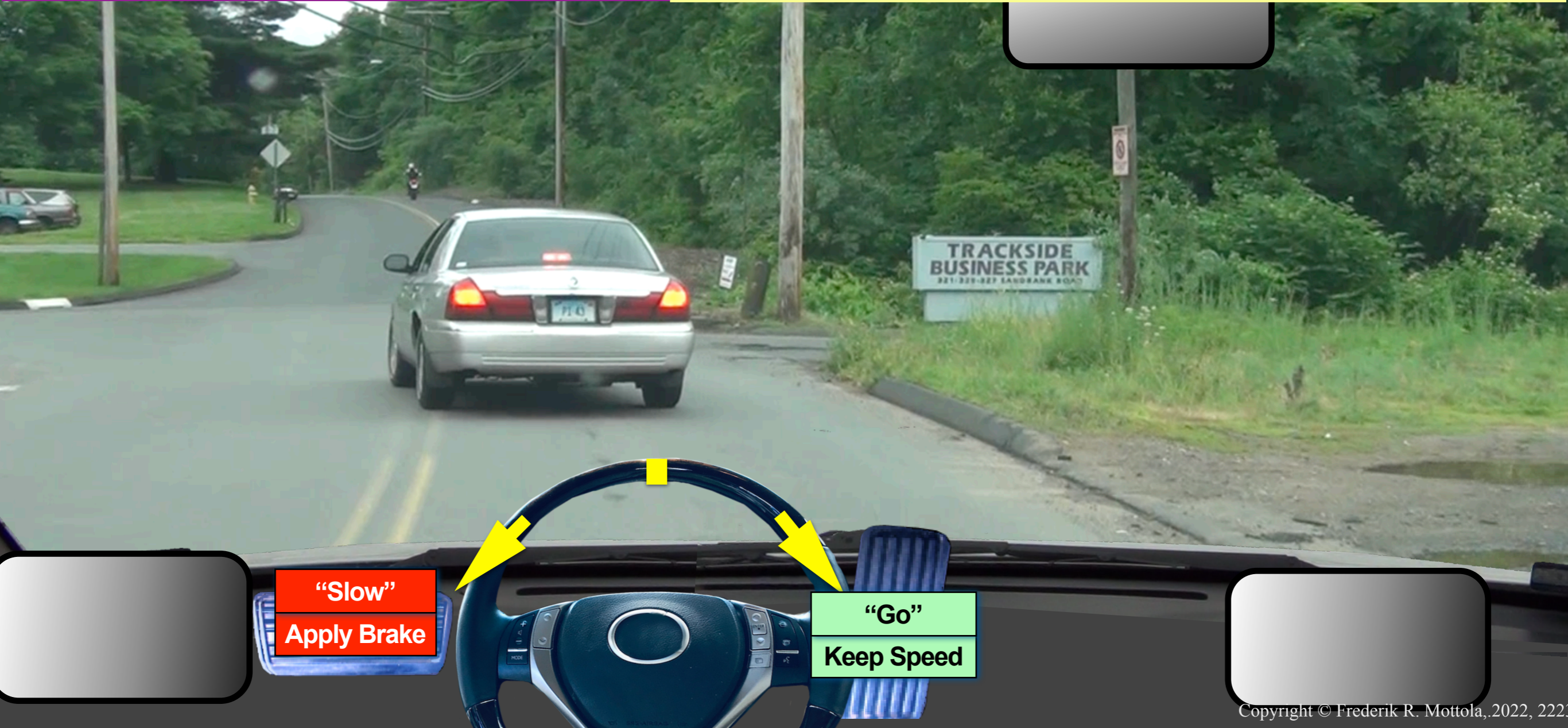

# Response

Your POT is “Closed.” This is a “Slow” condition requiring you to brake until the driver ahead completes the turn. You don’t want to be a zigzagger and swerve around it.

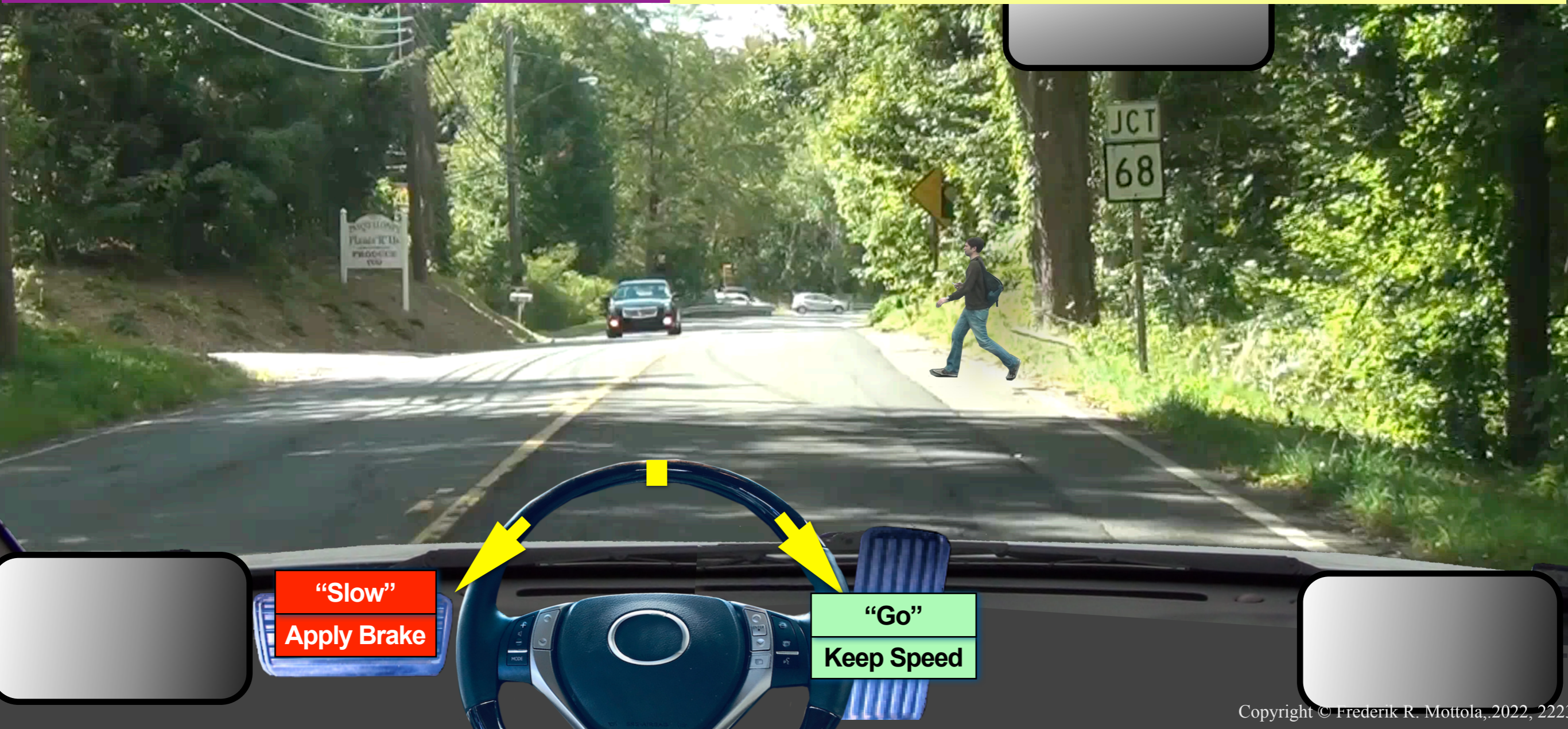

You're traveling at the same speed as the vehicle ahead. Is your POT (Path-OF-Travel) open or closed? What do you see in the Target Area?

Think of your response, then advance the slide.





# Response

This is your Target Area, which contains a left curve.



You have 4-seconds of separation space from the vehicle ahead, which gives you an "open" POT.
